Argumentation and Analysis <i>Is the student directly answering the question? Does the student develop justifications for his/her ideas and establish the significance of the points? Has s/he established a clear understanding of the topic area?</i>	<i>The answer was clear and directly related to the question. The first and second points of the speech had good structure and were well developed. The third point was rushed and did not adequately back up the claim.</i>
Source Consideration <i>Does the speaker offer a variety of sources? Are the sources provided credible? Are appropriate citations used when citing a source?</i>	<i>There was a lot of New York Times being cited. While this is a good source, increasing the variety of sources presented will help you stand out. There were inconsistencies in the citation provided when offering a date for the source.</i>
Delivery <i>Is the student using voice, movement, and expression effectively? Is the speaker confident? Is there consistent eye contact? Is the volume appropriate?</i>	<i>The speaker was really engaging to listen to. It is clear the speaker has given this topic a great deal of consideration as the confidence was clear. When he got to the third point, he began rushing, which impacted his clarity.</i>

General Feedback:

The decision to offer Al Franken as the answer to the question was intriguing and a unique perspective on the topic. The first point about not shying away from his ideology was well done. The third point about how he would do in a general election was critical to answering the question effectively, but unfortunately, that's the point that was least developed. Work on your word economy in the introduction so you have more time in later parts of the speech.

Reason for Decision (Why did this presentation earn the rank you assigned?):

The speaker's time allocation hurt his overall ability to deliver sufficient justifications for each of his points.
